In Memory AL LIPTON



It is with deep sorrow that we have to report that Brother Al Lipton (Theta) who was the first President of the current Alumni Association passed away on November 13, 2014. Al was a young 97 years old.

Al Lipton (aka Alan Lipschultz) was inducted into the Theta chapter in South Philadelphia in 1934 and loved both Theta and Sigma Alpha Rho his entire life. Al was also a past Sigma Rho of the Theta chapter.

Past SER Fred Ratner relates his first encounter with Al Lipton. As a newly inducted Brother in the Theta chapter, then Sigma Rho (Harvey Goldenberg) told the chapter that he had received a call from "some old guy" from the 1930's. It was Al that had called and suggested that the Theta chapter plan a 50th Anniversary Reunion of the chapter as the anniversary approaches. In October of 1971 the Theta chapter ran their 50th Anniversary Reunion at the Broadwood Hotel (now a Hospital parking lot).

Years later at a dinner organized by Past SER Harold (Whitey) Weissman to plant the seeds to run a 70th Anniversary Reunion of Sigma Alpha Rho, Whitey schmoozed Al into running this Reunion. Unfortunately as the event approached, Al who was running 5 miles a day suffered a heart attack. Past SER and current Alumni Association VP Steve Wernick helped take control of the Reunion while Al was recuperating. Al so grateful to have recovered and been able to attend that he had tears in his eyes as he spoke at this 70th Anniversary Reunion. Al also co-chaired the 75th Anniversary Reunion



with Jerry Segal. Over one thousand alumni attended this Reunion.

When a number of Alumni decided to re-activate the Alumni Association (known as the Emerald Lodge in the 40's and 50's), Whitey Weissman declared, "It could only be Lippy as our first President".

Al and his wife Cissie operated a linen store in the Krewstown Shopping Center in Northeast Philadel-

phia for many years. Al and Cissie were snowbirds during the winter months in Florida for many years after retirement. In 1994, Al and Cissie decided to move permanently to Florida. Unfortunately Cissie passed away; and Al later married Hannah. Al and Hannah resided in Aventura Florida.

With Sigma Alpha Rho still in his heart, in 1998 Al helped organize the SAR Florida Alumni Association with the idea of holding a yearly brunch. Al continued to run this yearly brunch until a few years ago. Al always made a point to have something from Philadelphia at the Brunch (tastykakes, soft pretzels etc.). Many Brothers living, vacationing or wintering in Florida have attended the yearly brunches. The tradition that Al had started continues this year on Sunday, February 22, 2015. The Brunch is being coordinated by Mike Jacobs and Past SER Joel Hollander.

Al was a brother for 80 years who many of us will never forget. Rest in Peace Brother Lipton.
